Mayor Teixeira called the meeting to order at 9:05 a.m. Roll call was taken and a quorum of the Board of Supervisors was present. No quorum was present for the Parks and Recreation Commission. (It was not an agendized Commission meeting and both Commissioners were present as representatives of the Commission as well as interested individuals.) The Board and staff then embarked on a tour of the above listed parks and golf courses. Discussion including the condition of these facilities, present and proposed uses, present and proposed amenities, American General's default on the Fuji Park Exhibit Building contract, the night watchmen's quarters, funding, various types of users, tourist attractions, acquisitions, need for weed control, sprinkler problems, manpower shortages, need for small neighborhood parks versus larger centralized parks, need for maintenance costs to be included in bond issues, cemetery cribbing, tennis court surfaces, need for shade of Centennial's outfields six and seven, a roof leak at the Clubhouse, listed other facilities which the Parks Department maintains, and the need for landscaping along right-of-ways. No formal action was taken other than the following adjournment. Upon returning to the Community Center Supervisor Bennett moved to adjourn. Supervisor Smith seconded the motion. Motion carried unanimously. Mayor Teixeira adjourned the session at 11:36 a.m.
