CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL: Chairman Fettic called the meeting to order at 10:30 A.M. Roll call was taken and a quorum was present.

1. DISCUSSION WITH POSSIBLE COMMISSION ACTION - CONSTRUCTION OF NORTH EDMONDS DRIVE FROM HIGHWAY 50 EAST SOUTH TO THE INTERSECTION OF EDMONDS DRIVE AND STANTON DRIVE IN COOPERATION OF ADJACENT DEVELOPMENT: (1-010) Dan O'Brien explained the request for RTC support in participating with the developer, Eagle Valley Construction, in the realignment of North Edmonds Drive. Illustrations of the development project and the realignment of Edmonds Drive were provided. Mr. O'Brien advised that the total cost of construction would be approximately \$500,000, with the City being responsible for approximately \$360,000. It was suggested that at least at 20% cost savings would occur if and agreement with Eagle Valley Construction could be established to assume responsibility of the total construction and be reimbursed by Carson City for its' portion. Following discussion, Member Chirila moved to approve the concept of the realignment of Edmonds Drive and direct Staff to pursue an agreement with the contractor to be brought before the Board of Supervisors for approval. Chairman Fettic seconded the motion. A vote was taken and carried 2-0.

The next meeting was scheduled for April 26, 1989 at 9:00 A.M.

ADJOURNMENT: Member Chirila moved to adjourn the meeting at 11:00 A.M. Chairman Fettic seconded the motion. A vote was taken and carried 2-0.
